



NEWSLETTER - PRIVACY POLICY

ThinkIN China, as controller of personal data, informs you in compliance with the Section 7 of Legislative Decree 30.6.2003 n.196 and Article 13 of European Directive n.2016/679 that your data will be processed with the following objectives of data handling and its modalities.

OBJECTIVES OF DATA HANDLING AND ITS MODALITIES

The shared personal data ("Data") will be used in Newsletters ("Service") containing information and updates about our project, ThinkIN China ("Company").

Data processing for the Service may be carried out using automated or electronic methods.

OTHER SUBJECTS WHO CAN TREAT THE DATA

The Data may be processed by parties operating on behalf of the Company and by virtue of specific contractual obligations, in EU or non-EU member countries.

The Data may be disclosed to third parties to comply with legal obligations, to comply with orders from public authorities or to exercise a right of the Company in court.

The newsletter management platform is Mailchimp, [here](#) you can consult the privacy policy of Mailchimp. The email address is stored on the Mailchimp servers, Mailchimp provides information on the opening of the newsletter and the interaction with links in the text of the emails.

DATA STORAGE

The Data processed to provide the Service will be stored by the Company for a time that is believed to be strictly necessary in order to successfully provide the Service, no more of 5 years after the last consensus.

DATA CONTROLLER

Data controller is ThinkIN China, a project operated by Beijing Consulting Group, legal address Suite 1206, Tower 3, Zhuang 2000 Office Centre, Chaoyang Road, No.98 Bali Zhuang Xili, Chaoyang District, Beijing, China 100025.

DATA SUBJECT'S RIGHTS

The following rights are recognized to the interested party:

1. Right of access, i.e the right to request confirmation from the Company whether the data is being processed or not, and in this case, to obtain access;
2. Right of rectification and cancellation, i.e the right to obtain the correction of inaccurate data and / or the integration of incomplete data or the deletion of data for legitimate reasons;
3. Right to limit the processing, i.e the right to request the suspension of treatment if there are legitimate reasons;
4. Right to data portability, i.e the right to receive the Data in a structured, common and readable format, as well as the right to transmit the Data to another data controller;
5. Right of opposition, i.e the right to object to the processing of data if there are legitimate reasons, including the processing of data for marketing and profiling purposes, if any;
6. Right to contact the competent data protection authority in case of unlawful data processing.
